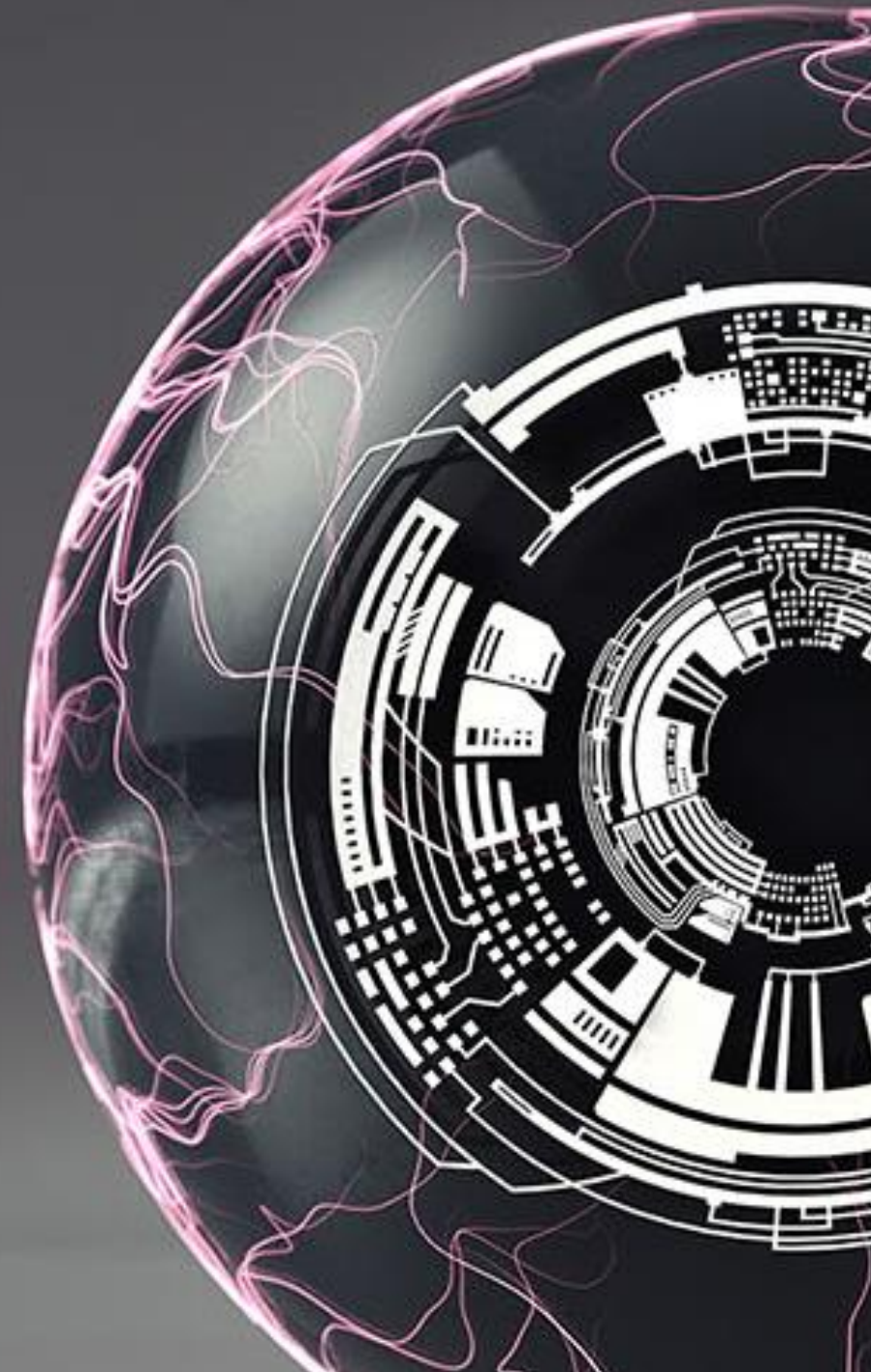




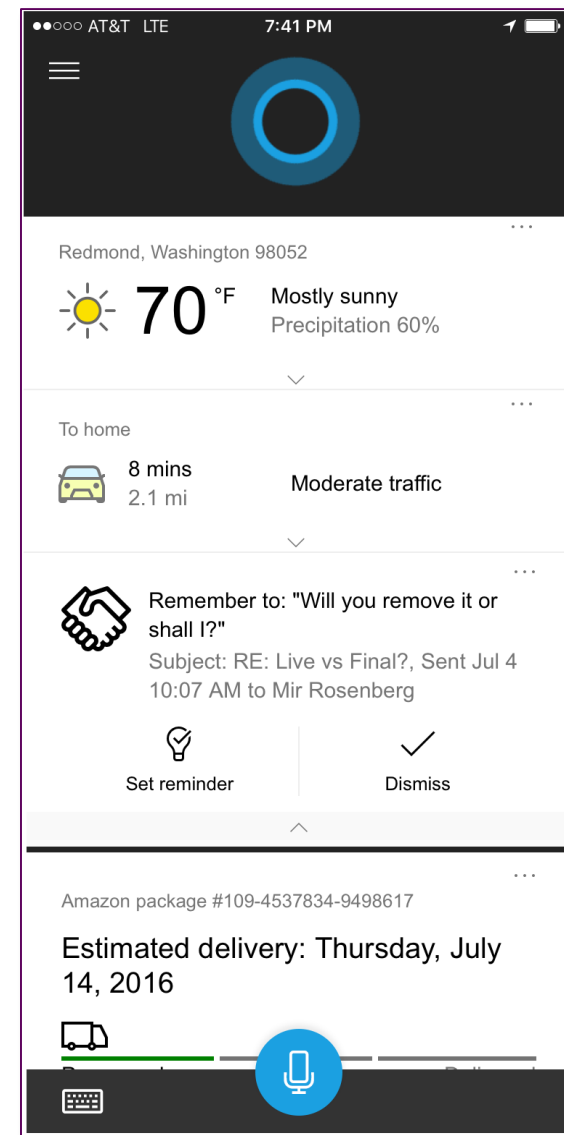
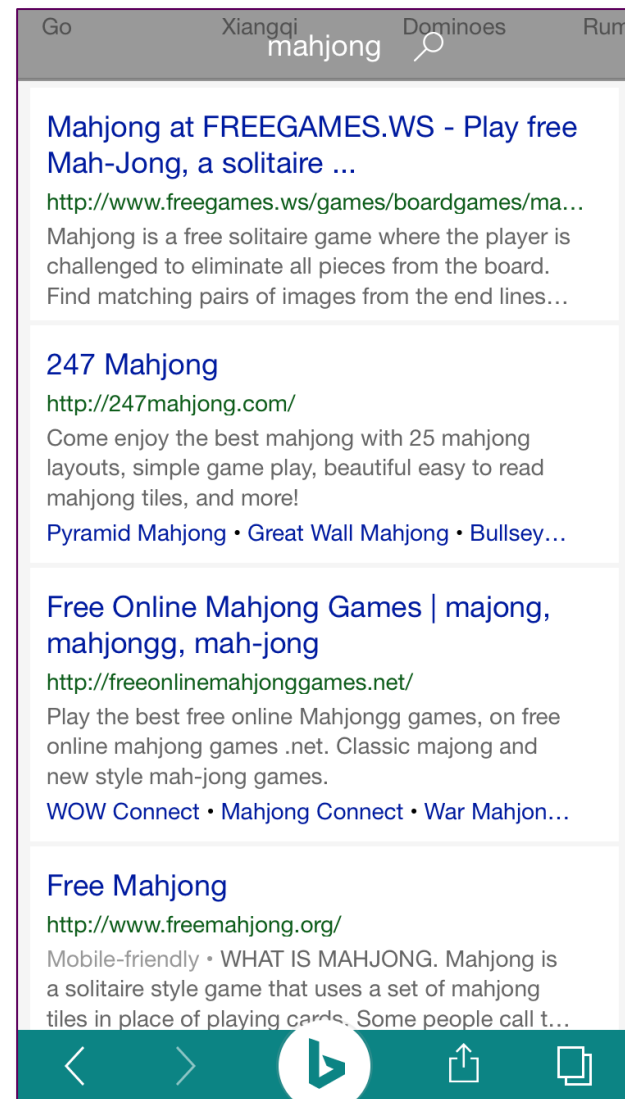

What is a large scale?

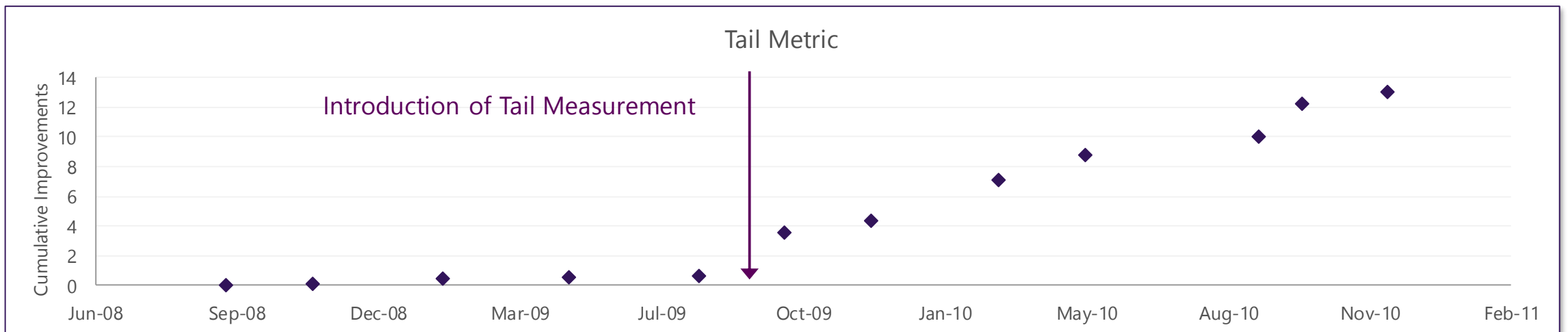
- Hundreds of billions of documents

Lesson #1: You get what you
measure

You get what you measure

- If you really want to improve something, start by measuring it. If you aren't measuring it, don't expect it to improve
- Measurement Framework:
 - What are your product goals? What are the key tasks and scenarios?
 - What signals are correlated to those goals?
 - Leverage those signals to build metrics that measure whether you are successfully moving towards your goals



Lesson #2: Data is powerful, Instrument Everything

Data is Powerful, Instrument Everything

- Can you build a chart of what is happening in your system?
 - If you can't, then don't even try machine learning
 - First build a great instrumentation pipeline and platform
- Data is powerful
 - Its unreasonably effective: more data > smarter algorithms
 - Its great to analyze and understand and get ideas for future improvements
 - Data helps you validate if your ideas are good (AB Testing)

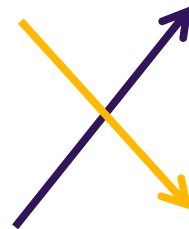

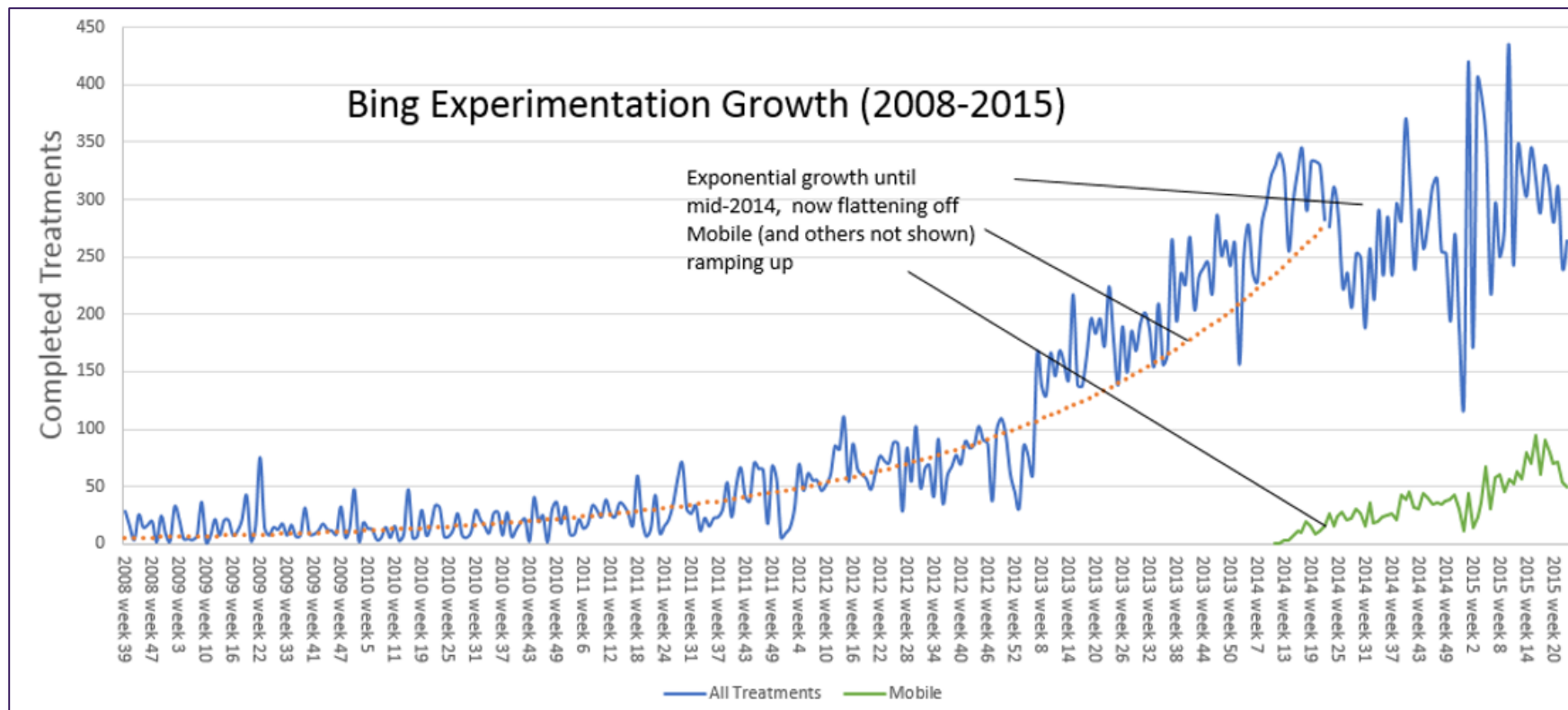
B

In the same amount of space we can put either 4 As, or 3 Bs

- Raise your left hand if you think A Wins
- Raise your right hand if you think B Wins
- Don't raise your hand if they are the about the same

Experiment a lot

- No matter how smart you are, it is really hard to tell what is the ideal product from intuition alone
- Solution: Experiment a lot, try different ideas in parallel, try them fast. Build, Measure, Learn
- Optimize experimental throughput. Its never fast enough, agility is important

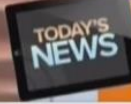

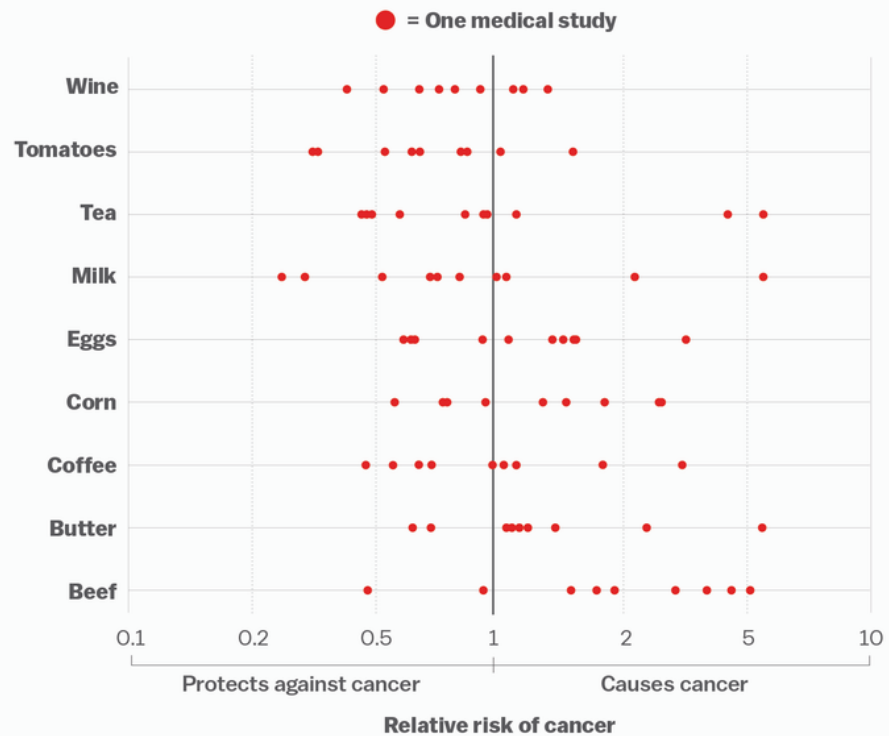

Scientists Say Smelling Farts Might Prevent Cancer

It has been a weird week in health news. P-Hacking

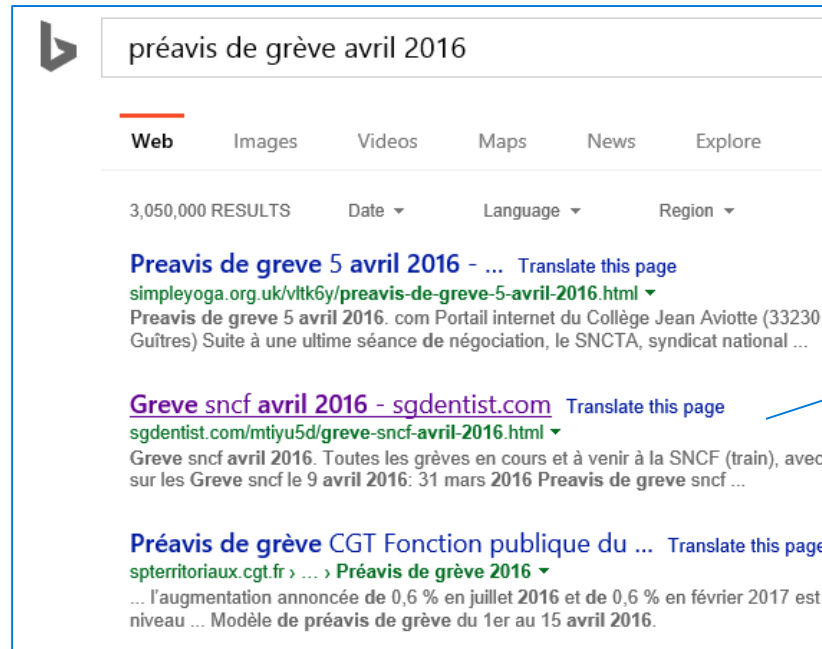
- Why does this happen?
 - Your team is under pressure to get results
 - You've empowered them with a large scale ML system
- Causes for accidental p-Hacking
 - Too many attempts
 - Experiments are underpowered / sample size too small
 - Accidental bias in control and treatment group
- Solution
 - Replication: Your real impact is measured on a final experiment on a completely new sample



Lesson #5: Prepare for Adversarial Conditions

Adversarial Conditions

- If you are making money, someone will want a piece of your business
 - Many bad guys out there
 - Others are good intentions but strayed to far
- Don't underestimate your adversaries
 - They are very clever, creative, and relentless
