

economic impacts (1)



1. Consumers of type θ choose the replacement rules $\{S(\theta), s(\theta)\}$ $S(\theta) = \operatorname{argmax} \left\{ F[\theta, k] - \theta p_k \left(1 + \tau_k^p \right) \right\}.$ $s(\theta) = \min \left\{ k : F[\theta, S(\theta)] - \theta p_{S(\theta)} \left(1 + \tau_{S(\theta)}^{\rho} \right) > F[\theta, k] - \theta p_{k} \right\}.$

2. The distribution $\lambda[\theta,j]$ of consumers of type θ holding good j

$$\sum_{j=0}^{J} \lambda[\theta, j] = \mu[\theta].$$

3. Rental markets for goods $j \in \{0, ..., J-1\}$ clear:

$$\int_{\theta} Q_D'[\theta,j] d\theta = \int_{\theta} Q_S'[\theta,j] d\theta.$$

4. Resale markets for goods $j \in \{0, ..., J-1\}$ clear:

$$\int_{\theta} Q_D^p [\theta, j] d\theta = \int_{\theta} Q_S^p [\theta, j] d\theta.$$


